Messrs. Alex. Koch & Sons, of 44 Doughty Street, W.C., publishers of the well-known annual, Academy Architecture, announce the approaching publication of a Portfolio of Twenty Plates reproduced from drawings of Egyptian Temples and Mosques by Mr. W. J. Palmer Jones. The reproductions are by lithography, the original drawings being done on the stone by Mr. Jones himself and the printing carried out under his personal supervision. The originals, remarkably clever drawings, are in charcoal—a medium eminently suitable for the presentment of these fascinating old monuments; and the lithograph reproductions, judging by the specimens which have been sent to the Institute for inspection, are admirable. 



Government House, Delhi: The Main Front.




Government House, Delhi: from the South.






Government House, Delhi, as seen between the Secretarial Blocks.
