

DIAGRAM SHOWING HOW TO TAKE A DEPRESSION MEASURE




DIAGRAM NO. 1
NORMAL FIGURE

The yard stick must always be straight up and down and not lean in or out at the top or bottom. Use the yardstick as shown in Diagrams 1-2 and 3.

Diagram 1 shows how to hold the yard stick and square.

Measure in for the waist depression from the edge of the yard stick to the hollow part of the waist which is 2 inches for a normal man, but can be more or less.




DIAGRAM No. 2
STOOPING FORM AND
SWAY TO FRONT

Diagram No. 2 shows the stooping and sway to the front form. The distance from the yard stick to the hollow part of waist is $21\frac{1}{2}$ inches, but can be more or less.

The distance from the yard stick in to the seat is $11\frac{1}{2}$ inches, but can be more or less.

When drafting trousers for this form deduct the seat depression from the waist depression before drafting and the difference gives you the correct waist depression for the trousers.




DIAGRAM NO. 3

Diagram No. 3 shows the erect form with large seat. When drafting a coat for a form of this kind, deduct the blade depression from the waist depression and draft the pattern. After the pattern is drafted add to the seat measure the amount you reduced the waist depression.

When drafting trousers draft them the full waist depression measure always.

HOW TO TAKE THE MEASURE




DIAGRAM No.1

Take the breast and waist measure and then place the square up under the arm as shown, and mark in the front and back of the arm at the top of square as Diagram No. 1.




DIAGRAM No.3

Place the edge of the square on the mark at the back of arm and square across as shown. Mark in the center of the back at the top of the square for the seye depth as shown in Diagram No. 3.




DIAGRAM No.2

Place the square over the top of the shoulder and mark in back of the square in front of arm seye as Diagram No. 2.




DIAGRAM No.4

Take the seye depth and waist length, also the length of seat and the full length as shown in Diagram No. 4.




DIAGRAM No.5

Take the strap measure from the center seam in the back of vest at the neck down to the mark in front of arm as shown on Diagram No. 5.




DIAGRAM No.6

Take the over shoulder measure from the scye depth mark in the center of the back, across the shoulder and down to the mark in front of the arm as shown on Diagram No. 6.





DIAGRAM No.7

Take the blade measure from the mark in front of arm, around to the seam in the center of the back as shown on Diagram No. 7.



HOW TO ENLARGE MEASURE

To get an easy sack coat you should increase the breast and waist measure one or more sizes or as much as is wanted for ease.

None of the other measures should be changed if they have been taken correctly, namely: the strap measure, the oversoulder measure or scye depth.


In cutting overcoats take the measures of the vest, and enlarge the breast and waist measures 3 inches for regular overcoat, or as much as is wanted for size.

Do not enlarge the oversoulder, strap measure or scye depth as you add to the above measures by dropping the arm scye which is shown on the drafts.

If the above is followed out closely you will get good results.



HOW TO OPEN VEST FOR A STOUT MAN AS SHOWN ON DIAGRAM



The solid black lines show the vest after it is opened.

The broken lines show the vest before it is opened.

The solid black space from the side at the point D across to the front at point C shows how the vest is filled in.

Draw a line back from the pocket to A and cut the pattern from A in to B and thru to C.

Open the pattern from A to D $\frac{1}{4}$ of an inch for each inch stout.

Paste a piece of paper over the opening from the front point at C back to point D and draw a line from D to B.

Take out the space between A and D and into B.

This leaves the solid black space filled in as diagram, which gives the length over the stomach for the stout.

This finishes the diagram.







DIAGRAM SHOWING NORFOLK OVER REGULAR
SACK COAT





A is located at the front sleeve notch.

Square across from A to get B.

Cut the pattern thru from A to B and add $\frac{1}{2}$ inch for seams.

C is located at the top of the side seam in the arm scye.

Square across from C to get D.

Open the pattern thru from C to D and allow $\frac{1}{2}$ inch for seams.

A to E is 3 inches.

E to E-1 is 2 inches.

Draw a line from E down to get E-2.

E-2 to E-3 is 2 inches. This forms the front strap.

Lay a piece of paper under the pattern and trace off the front strap.

F is located at the normal waist line.

F-1 is located at the normal waist line.

F-2 is located at the normal waist line.

Draw a line from F-2 to the front of coat above the bottom button 1 inch to get F-3.

Go down from F, F-1, F-2 and F-3 for the width of belt 2 inches and shape as diagram.

G is half way between F and F-1.

G to G-1 is 1 inch.

G to G-2 is 1 inch.

Square up from G-1 to locate G-4.


Square up from G-2 to locate G-3.

Lay a piece of paper under the pattern and trace off the back strap.


Open the pattern thru at the side seams and lay the side seams of fore part and back together.

Lay a piece of paper under the pattern and trace off the belt.

This finishes the diagram.



HOW TO OPEN A COAT FOR A STOUT MAN AS SHOWN ON DIAGRAM



Open the pattern at the under arm seam from the arm hole down to the pocket at H. Cut thru pattern from H to H-1 which is $\frac{1}{2}$ inch back from the front edge of pocket.

Open the pattern from H-1 to D-6.

Open the pattern as diagram at H $\frac{1}{4}$ inch for each inch stout or as much as you want to give for ease.

Cut a strip of paper the shape of the opening from H to H-1 and D-6.

Paste the strip of paper over the opening from D-6 to H-1 and H.


The solid black shown on diagram is how the coat is to be filled in.

Cut from H in to H-1 and take out the white space from top of pocket at H and into H-1.

Take off the side body at H as much as it laps.

This finishes the diagram for the stout.

DIAGRAM OF SOLID PINCH BACK



A and B is the normal waist line.

Come up from A and B 2 inches to get C and D.

Lay a piece of paper under the pattern and trace off the belt as at A, B, C and D.

E and F is half way between A and C and B and D.

Draw a line from E to F.

Add $\frac{1}{2}$ inch at F to get F-1.

Add $\frac{1}{4}$ inch to E to get E-1.

Shape the back at diagram.

E-1 to X is 2 inches.

Square up and down from X.

X to X-1 is $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches.

Square up and down from X-1.

Pinch in as much at X as you add at F as diagram.

Pinch in as much at X-1 as you add at E as diagram.

This finishes the diagram.



DIAGRAM OF HALF PINCH BACK




DIAGRAM 1.


Diagram 1 shows the normal waist line at A and B.

Go up from A and B 2 inches to get C and D.

Lay a piece of paper under the pattern and trace off the belt as at A, B, C and D.

E and F is half way between A and C and B and D.

Draw a line from E to F.







DIAGRAM 2.

Cut the pattern thru on line E and F as diagram 2.

Add $\frac{1}{2}$ inch at F to get F-1.

Add $\frac{1}{4}$ inch at E to E-1.

Shape the back as diagram at E-1 and F-1.

X is 2 inches in from E-1.

Square up from X.

X to X-1 is $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches.


Square up from X-1.

Pinch in as much at X as you add at F as diagram.


Pinch in as much at X-1 as you add at E as diagram.

If where the back is split thru is to be seamed up allow $\frac{1}{2}$ inch for the seams.

This finishes the diagram.



REGULAR TROUSERS



The measurements are as follows:—

Outside seam	41 in.	Waist	31 in.	Knee	19 in.
Inseam	32 in.	Seat	37 in.	Bottom	16 in.
Depression 2 inches.					

Square down and out from 1.

1 to 3 is the rise 9 inches.

1 to 6 is the outside seam measure 41 inches.

4 is half way between 3 and 6.

5 is $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch up from 4.

2 is $\frac{1}{8}$ seat up from 3.

Square out from 2, 3, 5 and 6.

3 to 7 is $\frac{1}{2}$ seat.


7 to 8 is $1\frac{1}{32}$ seat.

8 to 9 is 1-12 seat.
 9 to 10 is 1-32 seat.
 11 is half way between 9 and 3.
 Square up from 11 to get point 12.
 12 to 13 is $\frac{1}{4}$ waist plus $\frac{1}{4}$ inch.
 12 to 14 is $\frac{1}{4}$ waist plus $\frac{1}{4}$ inch.
 Draw a line from 13 to 7, this gives you point 15.
 Draw a line from 13 to 8.
 Draw a line from 14 to 2.
 16 is half way between 7 and 9.
 Square down from 16 to get point 17.
 17 to 18 is $\frac{1}{2}$ inch.
 18 to 19 is $\frac{1}{2}$ bottom or 8 inches.
 20 is half way between 18 and 19.
 Draw a line from 20 up thru the knee to 11, this locates point 21, at the
 knee.
 21 to 22 is $\frac{1}{4}$ knee measure.
 21 to 23 is $\frac{1}{4}$ knee measure.
 Draw a line from 18 to 22 and from 19 to 23 and up to point 2.
 Shape side seam from 9 to 22, and from 10 to 22.
 Shape from 13 down to 10.
 Take out dress from 13 to 15 and down thru 9 to 10.
 Shape side seam from 14 to 2.
 This finishes the fore part.

BACK PART.

Square out from points 1, 13, 2, 3, 10, 22 and 18.
 23 to 24 is $\frac{1}{2}$ inch.
 22 to 25 is $\frac{1}{2}$ inch.
 18 to 26 is $\frac{1}{2}$ inch.
 19 to 27 is $\frac{1}{2}$ inch.
 Draw a line from 27 to 24.
 Draw a line from 26 to 25.
 10 to 28 is $\frac{1}{8}$ seat.
 Shape from 28 to 25.
 Square up from point 8 to get point 29.
 29 to 30 is the depression measure 2 inches.
 Place long arm of square on point 15 and 30 so that the short arm of square
 rests on line 1 and apply $\frac{1}{4}$ of the waist measure plus 2 inches for
 seams and make up, which in this case is $9\frac{3}{4}$ inches on short arm of
 square, so that it falls on line 1 as diagram, and gives you point 31.
 Now draw a line from 31 across to corner of square and down to 30 and
 15 and shape the back seam as diagram dropping $\frac{1}{4}$ inch below point
 28.
 31 to 32 is 3 inches.
 32 to 33 is 1 inch.
 Take out V at 32 and 33.
 2 to 34 is $13\frac{1}{4}$ inches.
 Shape from 31 to 34 and from 34 to 24.
 This finishes the draft.



Square down and out from 1.
 1 to 3 is the rise 11 inches.
 1 to 6 is the outside seam measure 42 inches.
 4 is half way between 3 and 6.
 5 is $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches up from 4.
 2 is $\frac{1}{8}$ seat up from 3.
 Square out from 2, 3, 5 and 6.
 3 to 7 is $\frac{1}{2}$ seat.
 7 to 8 is 1-32 seat.
 8 to 9 is 1-12 seat.
 9 to 10 is 1-32 seat.
 11 is half way between 9 and 3.
 Square up from 11 to get point 12.
 12 to 13 is $\frac{1}{4}$ waist plus $\frac{1}{4}$ of an inch.
 12 to 14 is $\frac{1}{4}$ waist plus $\frac{1}{4}$ of an inch.
 12 to F is 1-6 abdomen measure.
 Square out from F.
 F to F-1 is $\frac{1}{4}$ abdomen measure.
 F-2 is $\frac{1}{4}$ of an inch from F-1.
 F-3 is 1-32 waist up from 13.
 Draw a line from 14 to F-3.
 Draw a line from F-3 to F-1 and from F-3 to F-2.
 Draw a line from 27 to 24.
 Draw a line from 26 to 25.
 10 to 28 is $\frac{1}{8}$ seat.
 Shape from 28 to 25.
 Square up from point 8 to get point 29.
 29 to 30 is incline measure at waist 2 inches.
 Place long arm of square on points 15 and 30 so that the short arm of square rests on line squared back from 1—now apply $\frac{1}{4}$ of the waist measure plus 2 inches for seams and make up, which in this case is $12\frac{1}{2}$ inches on short arm of square so that it falls on line squared back from 1 as diagram and gives you point 31, now draw a line from 31 across to corner of square and down to 30 and 15.
 Now shape the back seam as diagram dropping $\frac{1}{4}$ of an inch below point 28.
 31 to 32 is 3 inches.
 32 to 33 is 1 inch.
 Take out V at 32 and 33.
 2 to 34 is $1\frac{3}{4}$ inches.
 Shape from 31 to 34 and from 34 to 24.
 This finishes the draft.

GOLF TROUSERS



The measurements are as follows:—

Outside length ... 30 in.	Knee length ... 23 in.	Knee ... 15½ in.
Inseam length ... 21 in.	Small of knee length ... 25 in.	Small of knee ... 14 in.
Waist ... 32 in.	Calf length ... 29 in.	Calf ... 15 in.
Seat ... 38 in.	Rise ... 9 in.	Depression ... 2 in.

Square down and out from 1.

1 to A is the rise 9 inches.

1 to B is the knee length.

1 to C is the small of knee length plus 1 inch.

1 to D is the calf length plus 1 inch.

Square out from A, B, C, and D.

A to A-1 is ½ seat plus ½ inch.

A-1 to A-2 is 1-12 seat plus ½ inch.

Square up and down from A-1 to get points
2 and B-1.

Point 15 is ⅓ seat up from A-1.

A-3 is half way between A and A-2.

Square up from A-3 to locate 3.
4 is $\frac{1}{4}$ waist plus $\frac{1}{4}$ inch from 3.
5 is $\frac{1}{4}$ waist plus $\frac{1}{4}$ inch from 3.
Draw a line from 5 to A-1.

A to A-4 is 1 inch.

Draw a line from A-4 to 4.

B-1 to B-2 is $\frac{1}{2}$ the knee measure.

B-2 to B-3 is 1 inch.

Square down from B-3 to get C-1.

B-1 to B-4 is 1 inch.

Square down from B-4 to get C-2.

Draw a line from A-2 to C-2.

Draw a line from A-4 to C-1.

Form 4 small pleats with the amount C-1 to C-2 is larger than small of knee measure as diagram.

C-3 is half way between C-1 and C-2.

C-3 to C-4 is $\frac{1}{4}$ small of knee plus $\frac{1}{4}$ inch.

C-3 to C-5 is $\frac{1}{4}$ small of knee plus $\frac{1}{4}$ inch.

Square down from C-3 to locate D-1.

D-1 to D-2 is $\frac{1}{4}$ calf measure plus $\frac{1}{4}$ of an inch.

D-1 to D-3 is $\frac{1}{4}$ calf measure plus $\frac{1}{4}$ of an inch.

Draw a line from C-5 to D-2 and C-4 to D-3.

Shape from 5 to A-2.

Shape from 4 thru A-4 and down to C-1.

Shape from D-2 to D-3 extending $\frac{1}{2}$ inch below D-1 as diagram.

BACK PART.

Square out from 1, A-2 and A-4.

20 is 2 inches in from 5 or the depression measure.

A-5 is $\frac{1}{3}$ seat from A-2.

A-6 is 2 inches from A-4.

C-6 is $\frac{1}{2}$ inch from C-2.

C-7 is $\frac{1}{2}$ inch from C-1.

Draw a line from A-5 to C-6.

Draw a line from A-6 to C-7.

C-4 to E is $\frac{1}{2}$ inch.

C-5 to E-1 is $\frac{1}{2}$ inch.

D-2 to E-2 is $\frac{1}{2}$ inch.

D-3 to E-4 is $\frac{1}{2}$ inch.

Draw a line from E to E-4.

Draw a line from E-1 to E-2.

Place your square on points 15 and 20 so that the short arm of square rests on line squared out from 1, and apply your waist measure plus 2 inches for the seams and V on line 1 to get point X.

Draw a line from 15 up thru 20 to top of square to get X-1.

X-2 is $\frac{1}{2}$ inch above X.

Draw a line from X-2 to X-1.

Draw a line from X-2 to A-6.

Shape from X-2 thru A-6 and down to C-7.

Shape the back seam from X-1 thru 15 and out to A-5.

Take out 1 inch V as diagram.


Take out the same amount in pleats on back part at bottom as on forepart.

Cut off the cuff and allow $\frac{1}{4}$ inch for seam on each the top of cuff and bottom of pants.

This same draft will cut knickerbocker trousers and instead of using the cuff at the bottom use a $1\frac{1}{4}$ inch band.

This finishes the draft.

Outside seam l'n'h 37 in.
 Inseam length 28 in.
 Waist 32 in.
 Seat 38 in.

Knee $15\frac{1}{2}$ in.
 Small of knee 14 in.



 2 to 6 is the inseam measure 28 inches.
 Square out from 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6.
 2 to 7 is $\frac{1}{2}$ seat.
 7 to 8 is $\frac{5}{8}$ of an inch.
 8 to 9 is 1-12 seat.
 9 to 10 is $\frac{5}{8}$ of an inch.
 11 is half way between 9 and 2.
 Square up from 11 to get point 12.
 12 to 13 is $\frac{1}{4}$ waist plus $\frac{1}{4}$ of an inch.
 12 to 14 is $\frac{1}{4}$ waist plus $\frac{1}{4}$ of an inch.
 Draw a line from 8 to 13.
 8 to 15 is $\frac{1}{8}$ seat.
 Square down from 8 to get point 16.
 17 is half way between 6 and 16.
 18 is 1 inch from 17.
 Draw a line from 18 to point 11, this gives
 you points A, B, C, as diagram.
 A to A-1 is $\frac{1}{8}$ knee.
 A to A-2 is $\frac{1}{4}$ knee.
 B to B-1 is $\frac{1}{8}$ small of knee.
 B to B-2 is $\frac{1}{4}$ small of knee.
 C to C-1 is $\frac{1}{8}$ calf.
 C to C-2 is $\frac{1}{4}$ calf.
 18 to D is 1-3 inch the size of the ankle or 3
 inches.
 D to D-1 is half of the ankle measure or $4\frac{1}{2}$
 inches.
 2 to 2-1 is $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches.
 Draw a line from 14 to 2-1 and from 2-1 to
 B-1 down through C-1 and D-1, this gives you
 the ease at A-1 for the bend at knee.
 Draw a line from 9 to A-2.

 Shape from 10 to B-2 extending $\frac{1}{4}$ of an
 inch out at point A-2.
 Shape from A-2 through B-2 and C-2 down to
 D as diagram.
 Shape outside seam as diagram from 14 to
 2-1 to B-1, C-1 and down to D-1.

BACK PART.

Square out from points 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 10.
 Square up from point 8 to get point 20.
 20 to 21 is the incline measure at waist 2
 inches.
 Draw a line from 9 through 21 and extend
 the line 5 inches always above point 21,
 which gives you point 22.
 22 to 23 is $\frac{1}{4}$ waist plus 2 inches.
 2-1 to 2-2 is two inches.
 Draw a line from 2-2 through 23 to find point
 24.
 2-2 to 24 is the same distance as from 2-1
 to 14.
 Draw a line from 22 to 24 and take out a $\frac{3}{4}$
 inch V as diagram.
 10 to 25 is $\frac{1}{8}$ seat.
 B-2 to B-3 is $\frac{1}{2}$ of an inch.
 C-2 to C-3 is $\frac{1}{2}$ of an inch.
 D to D-2 is 1 inch.
 Shape back part from line 22 to 21, down to
 25, shape from 25 to B-3, C-3 and down
 to D-2.
 From B-2 to B-1 and from B-3 to B-4 is the
 small of knee measure plus 1 inch.
 From C-2 to C-1 and from C-3 to C-4 is the
 calf measure plus 1 inch.
 From D to D-1 and from D-2 to D-3 is the
 ankle measure plus $3\frac{1}{2}$ inches.
 Take out $1\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch V in center of back
 part as diagram.
 Split the back part through at point 3 and
 A-2 take $\frac{1}{2}$ of an inch out above A and
 $\frac{1}{2}$ of an inch out below A, making 1 inch
 in all—take the inch out as diagram.


Square down and out from A.
A to A-A is $\frac{1}{8}$ breast plus $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch.
A to B is the same as A to A-A.
A-A to C is $\frac{1}{2}$ breast.
C to D is $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches.
A to D gives the proportions for the scye depth.
A-A to D gives the proportions for the strap measure.
A to E is the waist length 17 inches.
Square out from D and E.
E to E-1 is the waist depression 2 inches.
Draw a line from E-1 to B to locate point D-1.
D-1 to D-2 is 1 inch.
D-2 to D-3 is the blade measure $11\frac{1}{4}$ inches.
Square up from D-3 to locate D-D.
D-4 is half way between D-1 and D-3.
D-5 is $11\frac{1}{2}$ inches in front of D-4.
Square up from D-5.
A to 1 is $\frac{1}{8}$ breast plus $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch.
Square up from 1.
D-D to X is $\frac{1}{8}$ breast plus $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch.
Draw a line from X to A to get point 2 above 1.
D-3 to D-6 is one half the width of back from D-5 to D-2 or 3 5-16 inches.
Square up from D-6 to get point A-1.
Draw a line from A-1 to B to locate 3.
Draw a line from 2 to 3.
D-7 is one half the breast measure from D-2 or 18 inches.
D-8 is $11\frac{1}{4}$ inches out from D-7.
E-1 to E-2 is 2 inches.
E-2 to E-3 is one half the waist measure or 16 inches.
E-4 is $11\frac{1}{4}$ inch out from E-3.
Square down from E-3.
Draw a line from E-4 up thru D-8.
4 is $\frac{1}{4}$ breast from 2.

5 is $\frac{1}{4}$ breast less $\frac{1}{4}$ inch from A-1.
6 is $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch below 5.
X-1 is $\frac{1}{2}$ breast plus 1 inch from D-8.
X-2 is $\frac{1}{2}$ breast plus 1 inch from D-1.
E-5 is $\frac{1}{2}$ waist plus 1 inch from E-4.
E-6 is $\frac{1}{2}$ waist plus 1 inch from E-1.
Shape from X-1 to E-5 and from X-2 to E-6.
X-3 is 1 inch below D-5.
X-4 is 1 inch below D-3.
Draw a line from X-4 to X-3.
Shape top of back from A to 2.
Shape shoulder from 6 to A-1.
Shape front of arm scye from 6 down thru D-3.
Shape from 4 thru D-5 and down.
A-3 is $\frac{1}{8}$ breast plus $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch up from A-1.
10 is 2 inches below E-1.
A-3 to G is the side length plus 1 inch.
A-3 to G-1 is the full length plus 1 inch.
Shape from 10 to G and from G to G-1.
A-1 to A-4 is $\frac{1}{2}$ inch.
